Having overcome the well-known difficulty of tempering a very thin piece of steel of irregular shape and thickness; these knives are hammered thin to within about an inch, or less of the handle before tempering, thus making the grain finer and the cost of grinding less, although the medium priced knives are thin only at the edge. However, knives of the ordinary thickness will be sent, if ordered. Old round knives will be ground and returned, post-paid for 30 cents cash in advance.
